

# Fifth Sunday of Lent





Dear brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

What's the difference between a covenant and a contract? In our modern world, it's easy to mix them up, but they're quite distinct. A contract is an agreement between two parties, usually involving the exchange of goods or services. It's limited in scope and centered on a specific transaction. Con-

tracts can also be broken or ended. Covenants, however, are not like this.

A covenant is a sacred bond between God and people or between individuals in a way that mirrors God's commitment. It's not about a transaction but a deep promise that includes personal commitment, loyalty, and, most importantly, love. Covenants are meant to last forever, transcending simple exchanges. They are built on commitment, love, faithfulness, and trust, unlike contracts.

This weekend's first reading from Jeremiah highlights the nature of a covenant. God promises to always be faithful to us, even when we stray. He vows to write His law in our hearts, making us His people, and to forgive our sins. This covenant centers on God's love for us and our reciprocal love for God.

As Holy Week approaches, we recall this divine covenant, upheld by the sacrifice of God's only Son, Jesus Christ, who forgave our sins by dying on the Cross.



fend their sexual innocence and human dignity." Edge's first session will begin on Sunday, April 14, 2024.


