Our first reading and gospel have a lot in common. Both referred to the hopeless situation caused by leprosy. In Jesus's time, leprosy was a dreaded disease and Contacting leprosy was a matter of life and death. Though it was a physical sickness, according to Jewish religious beliefs leprosy was broadly associated with sin. That is, leprosy was a punishment for a sin committed by its victim.

Today, He encountered a leper. Instead of avoiding or stigmatizing the leper, he touched and healed him. The humble petition of the leper touched him: "If you want, you can cure me." As a compassionate savior and master, Jesus responded with both words and actions: "! Of course, I want to be cured!"


