# Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph





Dear brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

This Sunday, the Church honors the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, providing a meaningful continuation from the celebration of Jesus' birth.

The Holy Family serves as an exemplary model, showing us how to love God and our neighbors. Yet, the readings chosen for this occasion, particularly the second reading from the Letter to the Colossians, often spark controversy in today's context, particularly in the way St. Paul addresses wives and husbands.

St. Paul's instruction, "wives, be subordinate to your husbands," can seem jarring at first, especially when taken out of context. Critics might stop there, asserting a skewed interpretation of the faith and the Church. But St. Paul's message extends further, advising "husbands, love your wives... fathers, do not provoke your children."

This suggests that God's moral expectations apply to both husbands and wives. At the foundation of marriage, and by extension the family, is love. It's about mutual respect and affection. Husbands and wives are to love each other and their children "as is proper in the Lord." This kind of familial bond can only be nurtured through heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, and genuine love.

Families are the primary teachers of God's love. This week, we focus on our own families, recognizing that while they may be broken or imperfect, they are still the channels through which the word of Christ can enrich our lives.
